Youth with disabilities in the juvenile justice system encounter unique hurdles in accessing education. Often schools refer to the system without identifying a student's need for special education services or providing sufficient academic and positive behavior supports.

STUDENTS RECEIVED 1,600 EDUCATIONAL ADVOCACY SERVICES THAT KEPT THEM ON THE PATH TO STAY IN SCHOOL SCHOOL AND AWAY FROM THE JUVENILE JUSTICE **SYSTEM**



HOURS OF DIRECT 15,000 **ADVOCACY SERVICES WERE PROVIDED TO** PROBATION-INVOLVED YOUTH

HOURS OF TECHNICAL 6,000 **ASSISTANCE AND ADVICE** WAS PROVIDED TO STAFF, PROBATION-INVOLVED YOUTH, AND THEIR **CAREGIVERS**





More than HOURS OF COMPENSATORY **EDUCATION SERVICES** 1,000 WERE SECURED TO MAKE **UP FOR SERVICES NOT PROVIDED**
